NOTICE OF VACANCY

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for employment as Art Curator in the National Art Gallery, a parastatal body falling under the aegis of the Ministry of Arts and Cultural Heritage.

II QUALIFICATIONS

- A. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate <u>or</u> Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level".
- B. A degree in Fine Arts from a recognized institution

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Board.

Note

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above. However, candidates who, as at 30 June 2003, do not possess the qualification at A above will also be considered provided they hold –

- (a) A Cambridge School Certificate <u>or</u> Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board; and
- (b) A Master's Degree or a postgraduate diploma from a recognized institution in the field at B above <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board.

 Qualification at (a) under 'Note' should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above and (b) under 'Note'.
- C. Candidates should also:
 - (i) be computer literate; and
 - (ii) have a good knowledge of new concepts and ideas in visual arts.
- D. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

III AGE LIMIT

Candidates unless already in the Public Sector should not have reached their $\underline{45^{th}}$ birthday by the closing date for submission of applications.

IV SALARY
